- e. Sunday Mini Spring 2: TBD teams, 4 weeks of play. (currently 20)

3. Learn to Curls:

- a. 5 LTC's this year. 152 learners and 38 volunteers.
- b. Huge thank you to Jayden Thai who took over the LTC planning duties halfway through the year and did a fantastic job.

4. Group Events:
